NEW WEBSITE PROMOTES ENERGY, COST, AND ENVIRONMENTAL SAVINGS FROM ENERGY RECOVERY VENTILATION

ROCKLAND, MA — A new website, www.airxchange.com, shows visitors how Airxchange energy recovery ventilation (ERV) technology can reduce the cost of conditioning outdoor air by recycling up to 80% of the heating and cooling energy from exhaust air. The company offers a full line of ERV wheels (also known as heat wheels and enthalpy wheels) that are sold through HVAC equipment OEMs in integrated packaged systems, as accessories for packaged units, or as air handler options. The site includes a free “AIRX[®] Estimator,” which allows visitors to quickly estimate their potential energy and environmental savings from using an Airxchange ERV wheel. Also available on the site are three free, downloadable Airxchange AIRX software packages for modeling and evaluating the performance of the company’s ERV wheels.

To reduce the concentrations of indoor air contaminants (carbon monoxide, allergens, VOCs, radon, bacteria, molds, and viruses) in office buildings, schools, hospitals, hotels, and other facilities, the ASHRAE 62-2007 ventilation standard requires the continuous exchange of indoor air with fresh outdoor air. The energy cost related to conditioning this outside air can be staggering. Airxchange ERV wheels dramatically reduce this cost by capturing heating or cooling energy from exhaust air and returning it to intake air, thereby reducing the load on the HVAC system by as much as 80%. This reduction in load not only translates into significant ongoing cost savings, but also allows the downsizing of HVAC equipment, thereby reducing first cost and providing an immediate return on investment. Environmental benefits include CO₂ reduction through reduced building energy usage.
